

# CWSA 2006 Rendezvous Encampment Rules

YES, unfortunately there must be rules, bare with us, heed to the rules and we'll have a great time!

- Pets must be on a leash at all times. Leashes will not be more than 8 feet in length. Please clean up after your pet. Nothing worse than dog doo on your moc's.

- **NO OPEN FIRES.** Expect an Island County burn ban. All fires will be charcoal, Coleman or Propane. **NO OPEN FIRES**, violators will be asked to leave. **NO OPEN FIRES.** In case I wasn't clear enough, **NO OPEN FIRES.** Please call prior to leaving your last Rendezvous or home for the current burn ban regulations.

- Children should be under the control of a parent or guardian at all times to avoid injuries. Children are absolutely NOT allowed in or on any range without supervision. This includes the hawk & knife trail walk.

- **All Primitive campers, including children, MUST be in primitive dress at all times except for loading and unloading.** Violators will be asked to move camp to the modern area or leave the rondo. Day guests are the only exception.

- NO loaded weapons allowed in any camp at anytime.

- Children under the age of 16 will not be allowed to wonder about the rondo with weapons without an adult.

- Children are not allowed to play in or around the Porta Potties.

- The CWSA Rondo committee will investigate any instances of camp raiding, stealing, etc, and the individual(s) will be dealt with accordingly. Those found guilty by the committee will not be allowed to remain on CWSA property. More serious cases will be turned over to the Island County Sheriff's Department for investigation.

- Consumption of alcohol is permitted on site but must be contained to your camp. No unruly conduct will be tolerated. Consider your neighbors and keep the noise down after dark. **No under age drinking will be allowed in accordance with Washington State Liquor laws.** Violators will be turned over to the Island County Sheriff's Department.

- Vehicles will be parked in the designated area. We encourage you to unload and remove your vehicle from the primitive area as soon as possible.

- If there's any doubt about any of these rules or if you have questions please contact the Bourgeois, Segundo or any one of the Dog Soldiers.

- Please take out what you bring in. Our DUMP funds are limited.

- Above all we want each and every one of you to come and enjoy our rony. Please be safe, follow the posted rules and HAVE FUN!!!
